

DIVING BOARD USE FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THAT OF OTHERS.



Divers must line up orderly in a queue.

No pushing or shoving or horseplay or roughhousing at any time.

One person on the diving board at a time.

No more than one person on each step.

No walking back and forth on board.

No jumping off the sides of board at any point on the board.

Before diving, check around the water so you don't end up jumping on a swimmer.

No more than two (2) bounces per dive.

Once in the water, move away from the diving board area so another can dive in.

Lifeguards, Board Members, and other designated personnel acting on behalf of the Board are empowered to enforce all rules and diving board use. The Lifeguard has the authority to impose more stringent rules for member safety and enjoyment.

**WHEN NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY an adult member (18 years or older)
must be present with children under the age of 18.**

Safety is the paramount concern of the Board of Directors. Be careful and mindful of others. You are expected to know the rules and regulations. Cooperation will enhance the enjoyment of the pool and its facilities for Members and their guests.
